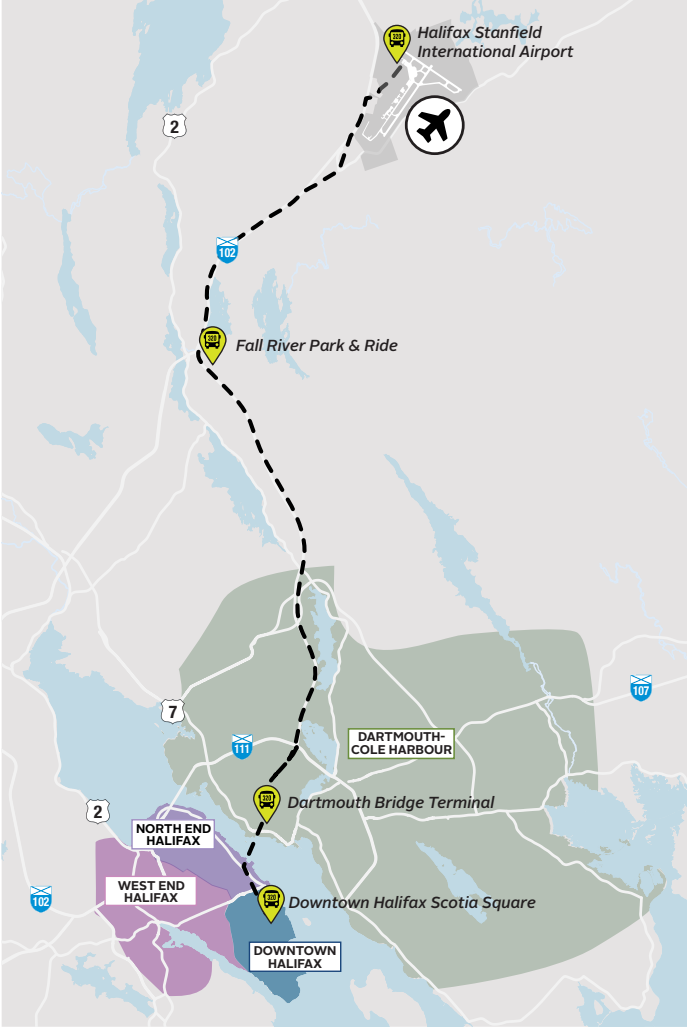

Getting from the Airport to Downtown Halifax

Taxis, Uber, Turo, and airport car services are available curbside at the Arrivals area. To travel from the airport to downtown Halifax you can expect to pay roughly \$60-\$70. **Vehicle rentals** are located on the lower level of the Airport Parkade. Halifax Transit also offers a limited-stop **Express Route Airport Bus** (320 Metro X) linking Halifax Stanfield International Airport to downtown Halifax. Adults/Students: \$4.25* Children/ Seniors: \$3.00*
*Note: Exact cash fare is required.

Bus

Halifax Transit offers affordable transportation around these three urban boroughs and beyond. Find routes and schedules at halifax.ca/transit.



Taxi/Uber

Casino Taxi (902-429-6666) and **Yellow Cab** (902-420-0000) are the most popular taxi services in the Halifax region. If you require wheelchair access call **Extra Care Taxi** (902-334-0334). **Uber** is now available in Halifax via the Uber app.



Ferry

For just \$2.75, enjoy a 15-minute ferry ride across the Halifax Harbour to explore both downtown Halifax and downtown Dartmouth.

Each of the urban boroughs on this map is highly walkable and bikeable due to the small size of our bustling city. New bike lanes are added every year.

Downtown Halifax

Downtown Halifax is the urban core of the region, complete with hundreds of restaurants, live music venues, unique local shops and world-class attractions. 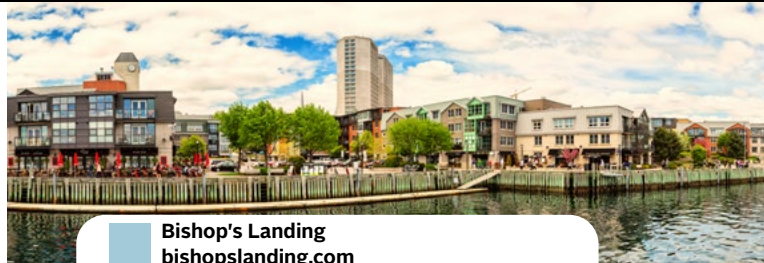

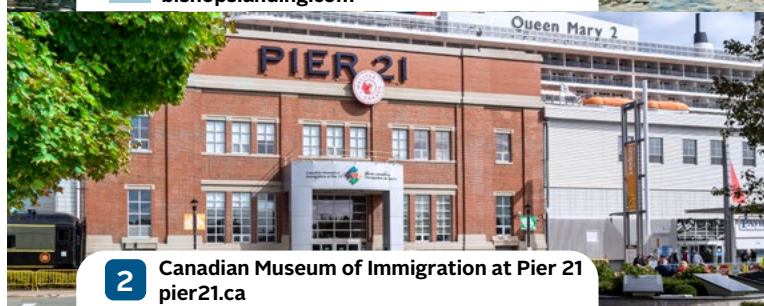

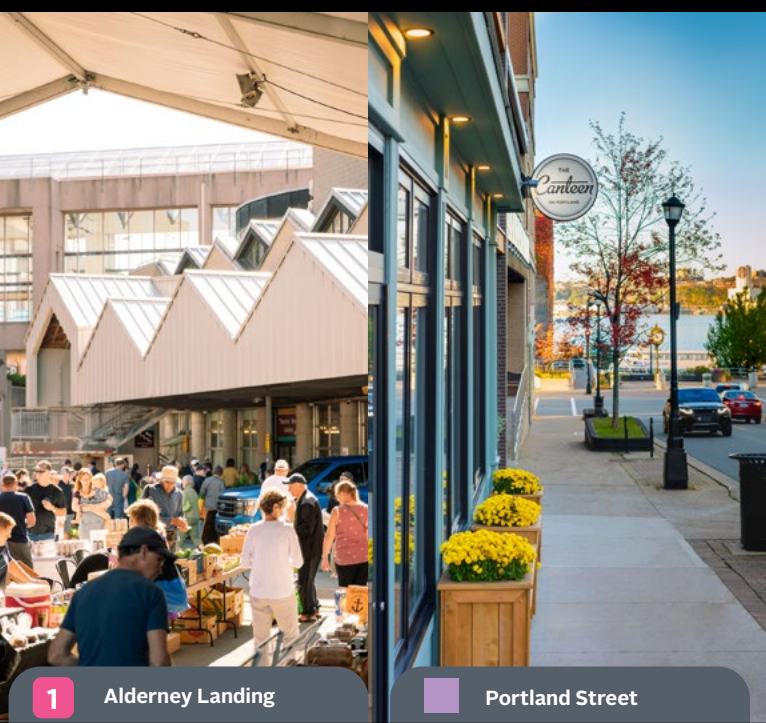
