

### Getting from the Airport to Downtown Halifax 🛛 💥

Taxis, Uber, Turo, and airport car services are available curbside at the Arrivals area. To travel from the airport to downtown Halifax you can expect to pay roughly \$60-\$70. Vehicle rentals are located on the lower level of the Airport Parkade. Halifax Transit also offers a limited-stop Express Route Airport Bus (320 Metro X) linking Halifax Stanfield International Airport to downtown Halifax. Adults/Students: \$4.25\* Children/ Seniors: \$3.00\* \*Note: Exact cash fare is required

## **Downtown Halifax**

Downtown Halifax is the urban core of the region, complete with hundreds of restaurants, live music venues, unique local shops and world-class attractions. The area is home to the lively Halifax waterfront which boasts one of the longest waterfront boardwalks in the world. This iconic destination offers stunning harbour views and plenty of things to do, from beer gardens and farmers' markets to playgrounds and museums.




